



TRINITY SAILING

Kit List for Sailing Holidays on Leader or Provident



Your clothing should be in soft bags, suitable for stowage in lockers. It is best to bring some warm items to wear at sea, as well as lighter ones to wear ashore. Bedding is provided on board and so there is no need to bring sleeping bags.

Passport

Please bring your passport with you, regardless of your planned voyage destinations/duration. If you do not have a passport, please contact our office using the number at the bottom of the page.

Recommended items:

- Stout footwear, such as walking boots/workboots, or deck shoes.
- Wellington boots or similar.
- Hats (both for warmth and protection against the sun).
- Swimwear and a bathing towel.
- Sun cream.
- A small torch.
- A towel and toiletries.
- 240V charger for any personal electronic devices. (Both vessels have a 240V ring main circuit that is usually live for around 3 hours each day, and can be used for charging: shavers, video cameras and mobile phones, etc.)
- 2 warm jumpers.
- 2 or 3 pairs of trousers.
- Several tops you can wear in layers, including some with long sleeves.
- Pair of shorts (in summer months).
- Warm gloves, if sailing at night. (We do not recommend the use of gloves when handling ropes.)
- Sunglasses and a spare pair of glasses if you wear spectacles.
- Waterproof clothing (jacket and salopettes are currently available to hire at no charge). Please complete the relevant section of the booking form if you would like to hire boots or oilskins, or phone the office in advance of your voyage.

If you play a musical instrument, other than the piano, consider bringing it with you.

Diet

We can cater for some special dietary requirements and so please ensure you fully complete the relevant section of our Booking Form if you have particular needs.

Mobile telephones

In the interests of the comfort and safety of guests, we ask that mobile telephones are turned off and left below whilst the vessel is sailing, during meal times and during briefings. There will be opportunities for you to make calls when the vessel is moored, or when ashore. If you need to remain contactable at other times, please inform the crew.
